Implementation of a telephone housing support service for the period of July 1

Vaudreuil-Dorion, June 16, 2022 - The Office régional d'habitation de Vaudreuil-Soulanges (ORHVS) announces the implementation of a temporary telephone support service for households that fear being without housing for the period of July 1st.

Faced with the scarcity of affordable rental housing that is currently plaguing the Vaudreuil-Soulanges region, many households are currently experiencing insecurity and fear, in some cases, of finding themselves homeless. In order to support these households, the temporary hotline will guide households to resources that can assist them in their efforts and provide them with telephone numbers and contact information for various assistance resources.

The helpline will be accessible:

- Monday through Thursday between 8:30 a.m. and noon and from 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Fridays, weekends and holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., from June 18 to July 17.

"The telephone assistance service will allow us to support households and refer them, according to their specific situation, to the resources available on our territory," said Manon Charest, director of the ORHVS.
